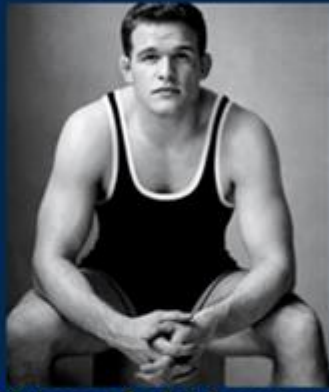

## WVU Beckley Campus WVU Tech Computer Lab Rules

Computer and other electronic equipment is for authorized educational use only. Unauthorized use or tampering with equipment is prohibited and will result in university disciplinary or criminal action.

NO FOOD, DRINK, OR USE OF TOBACCO IN ANY FORM is allowed in the labs.

No tampering with computers, monitors, projectors, or any settings.

Do not adjust monitor settings.

Do not unplug anything including power cords, network cables, or projector cables.

Do not remove tables, chairs, computers, monitors, or equipment from the room.

Log off of the computers before leaving the room. You are responsible for anything done under your user name.

Do not visit websites which might display sexually explicit graphics.

Do not remove HDMI cords from any device.

Lab users should maintain professional and courteous communication. Electronic devices should be used on a professional level. No obnoxious or belligerent behavior will be tolerated.

Behavior and activities that disturb other users or disrupt the operations of the lab are not allowed. This includes, but is not limited to: physical activities such as "rough-housing," loud music, etc.


With the exception of service animals assisting individuals with disabilities, no animals are permitted in a computer lab at any time.

Users may not download software on computer lab machines. The programs installed are to accommodate users with University-related coursework.

Academic work has priority in the Lab.

Please remember to clean up after yourself and remove your disk or USB flash drive. If you do forget something please check with the IT department at LRC 319 section to see if someone has returned it.

❖ **Live Safe App**



WVU Tech prides itself on being a safe and secure campus. Security on campus is a shared responsibility and we ask that you join together with other members of our community in keeping one another safe.



**Residence Hall Safety**

- Remember that residence halls are restricted to the students who live there and their guests. Don't allow strangers to enter behind you. If you notice strangers loitering suspiciously in the halls, stairwells, or outside the residence halls contact the [University Police](mailto:UniversityPolice@wvutech.edu) @ 304.929.2677 (COPS) or through the [LiveSafe App](#).
- Use main entrances and exits, except during a fire alarm.
- Always lock your doors and first floor windows even when you are just going next door to visit a friend or to the restroom. Most thefts are crimes of opportunity and occur within minutes or even seconds. Unlocked doors are favorite targets.
- Store valuables out of sight. Record the serial number, model number and brand name of any valuables in your room.
- Lock your doors while you are inside for personal safety. Be aware of who is at your door. Use your peephole to observe the person at your door. If you don't recognize them, do not open the door. Request that they leave any information they have at your door, so you may retrieve it when you feel safe.
- Do not tamper with door locking mechanisms. Never use any object(s) to prevent doors from closing and/or locking (e.g. trash cans or tape to keep the door from locking). This could allow an unauthorized person to enter the hall or your room.
- Do not share your keys or ID Card. Report losses immediately.
- Avoid leaving messages on your door advertising your departure or arrival times to alert thieves of your absence. Also consider removing your name if it is posted on your door.
- Never give your roommate's personal information to a stranger.
- Follow residence hall guidelines and policies including registering guests. They can be found in the [Bear Facts](#) online @ <https://students.wvutech.edu/>. Always escort guests. Guests should be accompanied by residents the entire time they are in the building.
- Notify staff of broken doors and security equipment.
- Take fire drills seriously and always evacuate when a fire alarm sounds (remember to lock your door).
