Campus Police

WVU Tech prides itself on being a safe and secure campus. We ask that you join together with other members of our community in keeping one another safe.



Safety Tips

University Police offer this advice to our community:

Be aware of your surroundings and take the necessary precautions to the loss of your belongings.

Purses, wallets, cell phones, tablets, gaming systems and textbooks are among the items that are reported missing most often.

Students, as well as faculty and staff, are urged to take all necessary measures to secure and protect personal belongings in residence halls, offices and vehicles in addition to office equipment and other vulnerable items.

We should always be on the lookout for suspicious activity and report it.

Take the extra time to secure items in the trunk or under the seat before leaving your automobile. The threat of a break-in is reduced if your belongings are not visible. Remember to lock your vehicle before leaving it.

University Police remind students to also practice safety in the residence halls

- Make sure your door is locked when leaving your room, even if you are only going next door. It takes less
 than 10 seconds for a thief to enter an open room and steal property.
- Do not leave messages on phones or social media accounts indicating how long you will be away or when you expect to return.
- Follow the safety in numbers rule when going out at night and arrange to go with friends/roommates. It is a
 good practice to scan your surroundings whether you're walking on campus, traveling by automobile or
 enjoying a shopping excursion. Call and request a University Police escort at 304.929.COPS (2677) to get an
 escort on campus to your vehicle or residence.
- Download and utilize the free LiveSafe mobile app from Apple iTunes or Google Play. The LiveSafe campus
 safety app enables a two-way communication system between students and University Police, lets you
 invite your friends to virtually watch you walk back to your residence hall (Safety Walk) and provides
 emergency resources.
- Do not leave valuables or property (purses, backpacks, books, personal identification, etc.) visible in or around the office, living or common areas.
- Keep emergency numbers on your phone. Call 304.929.2677 to report any suspicious person or activity.
- Wear seatbelts and ensure your passengers do as well. It can save lives and it's the law.
- Do not drink and drive. It may cost a life or permanent criminal record affecting your future.
- Park your phone while driving. It's dangerous and against the law.
- Take the time to be aware of your surroundings and any unusual activity.


